It is recommended that at Primary level each child should have on a **daily basis**:

- One hour minimum of English/welsh (if Welsh is first language)
- One hour minimum of Mathematics

and on a **weekly basis**:

- one and a half hours of Science
- one hour each of Technology, History, Geography, Art, Music, Welsh (second language) other language, and RE
- two hours of Physical Activities

This will ensure that your child receives access to a suitable education corresponding to a National Curriculum that is broad and balanced and suited to his/her age, ability and aptitude and also caters for any special educational needs.

If you child has a statement please indicate what special provisions you are making.

In the resources column please give details of who will be involved in teaching your child including parent, guardian and other tutors and whether they are qualified teachers (as defined by the Department for Education). You should also include access to e learning resources.
