Elective Home Education, Hampshire Inspection and Advisory Service (HIAS) – Education Officer, Family and Parenting Support – Co-ordinator)

Elective Home Education – Education of Children at home

Statutory responsibilities will be fulfilled, targeted delivery focussing on value added areas. Expenditure reduction options £50,000 1 FTE
