

Havering EHE Spend FOI Response January 2013

During the academic year 2011-12 it is estimated that the Local Authority spent at least £27,329 on services related to home education. This figure comprises 0.66 full-time equivalent of an administrative post and spend of £13,752 on the cost of teaching staff who visited those families who were home educating their children.

There were additional costs incurred in relation to the monitoring of home education by the Manager- Alternative Education Provision and the work undertaken by the Education Welfare Service and the Community and Child Psychology Service. However, as there are no records of how much time was spent on these issues it is not possible to produce accurate estimates of these costs.
