Query sent to DfE Funding Unit and Education Funding Agency August 3rd 2013

I have just come back from giving a week of talks to home educators at a national event. One of my talks was on 14-16 college and the two most pressing questions I was unable to answer were as follows:

Does the home educated young person have to be 14 already on September 1st in order to qualify, or is it about being 14 by the time the student actually starts the course at college?

And secondly, is it possible for a home educated young person to do a couple of subjects at one college and another couple at another college? And if so, does each college need to know that this is happening and is one college the main or primary college or do both colleges just fill in the ILR separately for part-time funding?

I would be very grateful for any guidance on this
