Elective Home Education it sits within Complex Needs SEN as part of Targeted Services. The rationale for this is that the Head of this service is a qualified teacher and was previously a School Improvement Officer. The Consultant who carries out the work, also a qualified teacher, has a substantive post as a Keyworker in the Integrated Youth Service.
