Please find the answers to your questions as follows:

1. Where home education currently sits in your authority

The management of Elective Home Education sits within the Education Access Service. Visits to support and assess education are undertaken by the Education Improvement Service.

2. Which line in the s251 table includes an allocation for home education services within the "other education and community budget" for example Education Welfare, School Improvement, Parent Partnership or Other

The funding comes from several budgets including Education Access, Education Improvement, Admissions, Shropshire Youth

3. The forward budget sum allocated to home education service and support

This is dependant on numbers at any given time

4. The amount spent on home education services for the academic year 2011-12 itemised to show staff costs, administrative/secretarial support costs

The following costs are approximated as the roles are not exclusive to EHE delivery:

Management: £5,000

Administration: £21,100

Consultants: £30,000

EWOs: £5,000

Shrop Youth: £3,000
