

Wolverhampton EHE Spend FOI Response March 2013

Parents in Wolverhampton who Elect to Home Educate (EHE) are able to access targeted family support services offered by the Multi Agency Support Teams as can families of those in school, but this is not subject to an EHE ring-fenced budget. This might include assessments from Educational Psychologists or specialist teachers, parenting support from the Parent Support Advisors or, should families decide to re-enter mainstream education, support from the Education Welfare Service.

The salary of the EHE Coordinator is projected for 2012/2013 at £55,554, including all on-costs. There is currently no dedicated administrative support to be costed. The authority does also support a number of home educated families of Traveller Heritage with culturally sensitive academic support sessions at a convenient Children's Centre. The cost for this is approximately £6,000. Two students were also supported to access FE courses.
